# f-stop Camera Bag and Backpack Review Guide

Thank you for agreeing to review one of our camera packs. To help you develop a review that accurately reflects the product and our brand, we prepared the following guide for you.

- 1. Brand (Logo and Brandguide here : <a href="https://shop.fstopgear.com/logo/">https://shop.fstopgear.com/logo/</a>)
  - a. The brand name is "f-stop". Please note that the spelling is ALL lower case. (even in the beginning of the sentences)
  - b. URL is <u>www.fstopgear.com</u>
  - c. You can find the specific product URL from then menu at the top of the home page.
- 2. Partner Brand If you are doing your review for use on one of our partner sites.
  - a. Confirm any brand requirements.
  - b. Spelling, URL for product, etc.
- 3. Key points about the f-stop brand
  - a. Founded in 2006 (2021 was our 15-year anniversary)
  - b. First camera bags on the market with modular storage system internal camera units (ICU's) several brands copied this concept.
  - c. Reliable supply chain products are all available for immediate shipment.
  - d. Customer service team available via phone, live chat or email.
- 4. Mountain Series
  - a. Camera Bag Insert (f/k/a Internal Camera Unit) part of the f-stop modular system
    - i. OPEN the Insert Cover / Lid before inserting into the bag
    - ii. Keep Insert cover folded under and behind the insert
    - iii. Insert the Camera Bag insert through the top lid (Handle of the Insert should face towards the Top lid (can be pulled out on the Handle)
    - iv. Camera gear should be visible and easily accessible through the back panel of the pack
    - v. Attach insert to the pack at internal attachment points on the internal sides of the pack (secures insert and keeps gear from spilling or being jostled)
  - b. All packs have an internal aluminum frame
  - c. Adjustable for maximum comfort carry loads

- i. Hip belt middle of the hip belt should lie over the hip bones not above as it might constrict the stomach.
- ii. Shoulder straps

Tighten the shoulder straps, but not too tight, because you want to make sure you are carrying the load on your hip belt.



#### iii. Load lifters

Adjust the tension of the load lifters (shoulder stabiliser straps) to pull the load closer to your back and your center of gravity.

### iv. Sternum strap

Close the chest strap to optimize the location of the shoulder straps and make the backpack more stable.

d. All packs have multiple external attachment points for the Gatekeeper Straps

  - a. 80-liter bag
  - b. Master Cine ICU
  - c. Great bag for
    - i. Long backcountry excursions
    - ii. Holds large, complex, kits including large cine rigs
- 6. SUKHA 70L
  - a. 70-liter bag
  - b. Several good ICU options.
    - i. PRO XL
    - ii. PRO Large
    - iii. Stack PRO Small on PRO Large
  - c. Great bag for
    - i. Long backcountry excursions
    - ii. Holds large, complex, kits including attached long lenses
    - iii. Great for carrying drones in ICU or accessory pouches
- 7. TILOPA 50L
  - a. 50-liter bag
  - b. Several good Camera Bag Insert options
    - i. PRO XL
    - ii. PRO Large
    - iii. Stack PRO Small on PRO Large
  - c. Great bag for
    - i. Long backcountry excursions
    - ii. Holds large, complex, kits including attached long lenses
    - iii. Great for carrying drones in insert or accessory pouches
    - iv. Back of the bag works great for sports equipment like skis, snow boards, etc.
- 8. AJNA 40L
  - a. 40-liter bag



- b. Carry-on compliant for MOST aircraft
  - i. Will fit in most overhead luggage compartments.
  - ii. Straps allow internal content to be compressed.
- c. Great bag for
  - i. Shorter backcountry excursions padded in shoulder straps and hip belt is LIGHTER than larger bags
  - ii. Holds large, kits including attached long lenses
  - iii. Great for carrying drones inside an insert or accessory pouches

#### 9. LOTUS 32L

- a. 32-liter bag
- b. Carry-on compliant for MOST aircraft.
- c. Great bag for
  - i. Shorter backcountry excursions padded in shoulder straps and hip belt is LIGHTER than large Mountain Series bags
  - ii. Depending upon camera bag insert, can holds kits with attached long lenses
  - iii. Great for carrying drones inside an insert or accessory pouches.
